Affiliates in Action - All Affiliates are automatically members of this committee. Affiliates assist in Special Committees and by working within the Board to promote its activities and events.

By-Laws and Parliamentarian - Monitors Board By-Laws to determine continued compliance with requirements of the National Association of REALTORS®, the California Association of REALTORS®, and with state and federal laws. The committee may comment, interpret, propose wording for changes, or recommend amendments to the Board of Directors.

Publicity - Enhances the REALTORS® image by coordinating community service programs to increase the visibility and recognition of the Board.

Education - Plans educational programs and events, with an emphasis on Continuing Education courses, to increase the knowledge and competence of our members.

Grievance - Reviews complaints by members and the public to determine whether or not a complaint will be forwarded to the Professional Standards Panel for hearing.

Legislative - Keeps members apprised of legislation affecting real estate and organizes member response to matters of importance to our industry.

Local Government Relations - Monitors and coordinates actions affecting our local communities. Acts as a liaison and keeps communication lines open with community leaders.

Membership/Orientation - Promotes Board membership, plans and conducts Orientation sessions for new members of the Board, makes recommendations to the Board of Directors on content of the sessions, and conducts new member induction at the Quarterly Luncheon Membership meetings.

Political Affairs/RAP - Promotes member participation in political process through Political Survival (CREPAC), REALTORS® Active in Politics (RAP).

Professional Standards - Panel is empowered to hear complaints charging violations of the Code of Ethics. Renders decisions and imposes penalties if applicable. Conducts Arbitration hearings and determines awards of funds in dispute.

Special Events – Responsible as Chairman for arranging social events that would be of interest to members and their families; Pot of Gold, Golf Tournament, Family Picnic and Las Vegas Night
